Microcystin Toxin Report

Here are this week's assay results for Microcystin levels at Lake Zoar sites. Results meet the assay kit's QC criteria.

The U.S. EPA and CT DPH currently advise a Microcystin threshold of 8.0 parts per billion (ppb; $\mu\text{g/L}$) for recreational waters.
